but you must avoid problems and replace it with cheer.



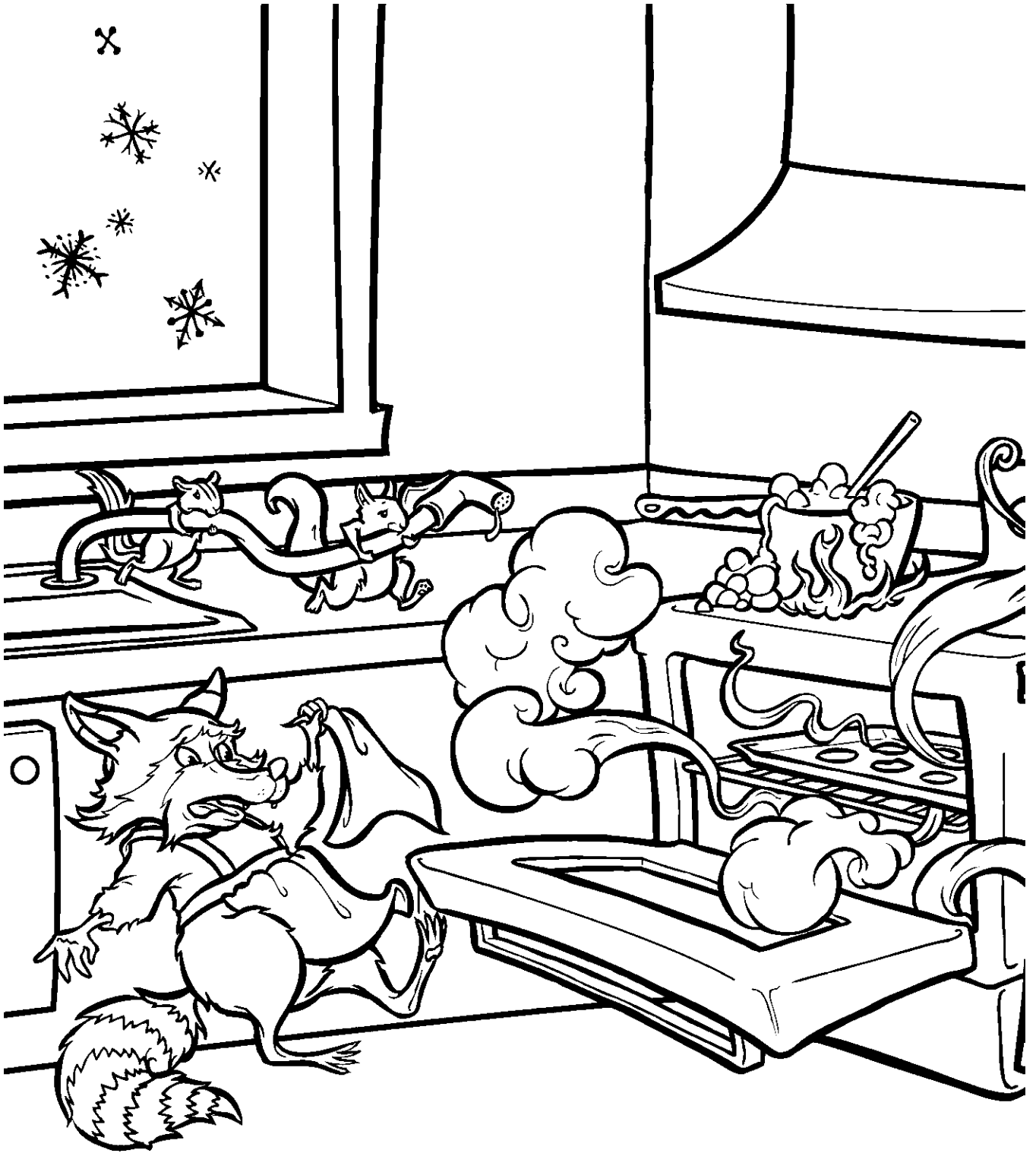
Turn off the tree lights when not in the room,

make sure the fireplace is danger free.



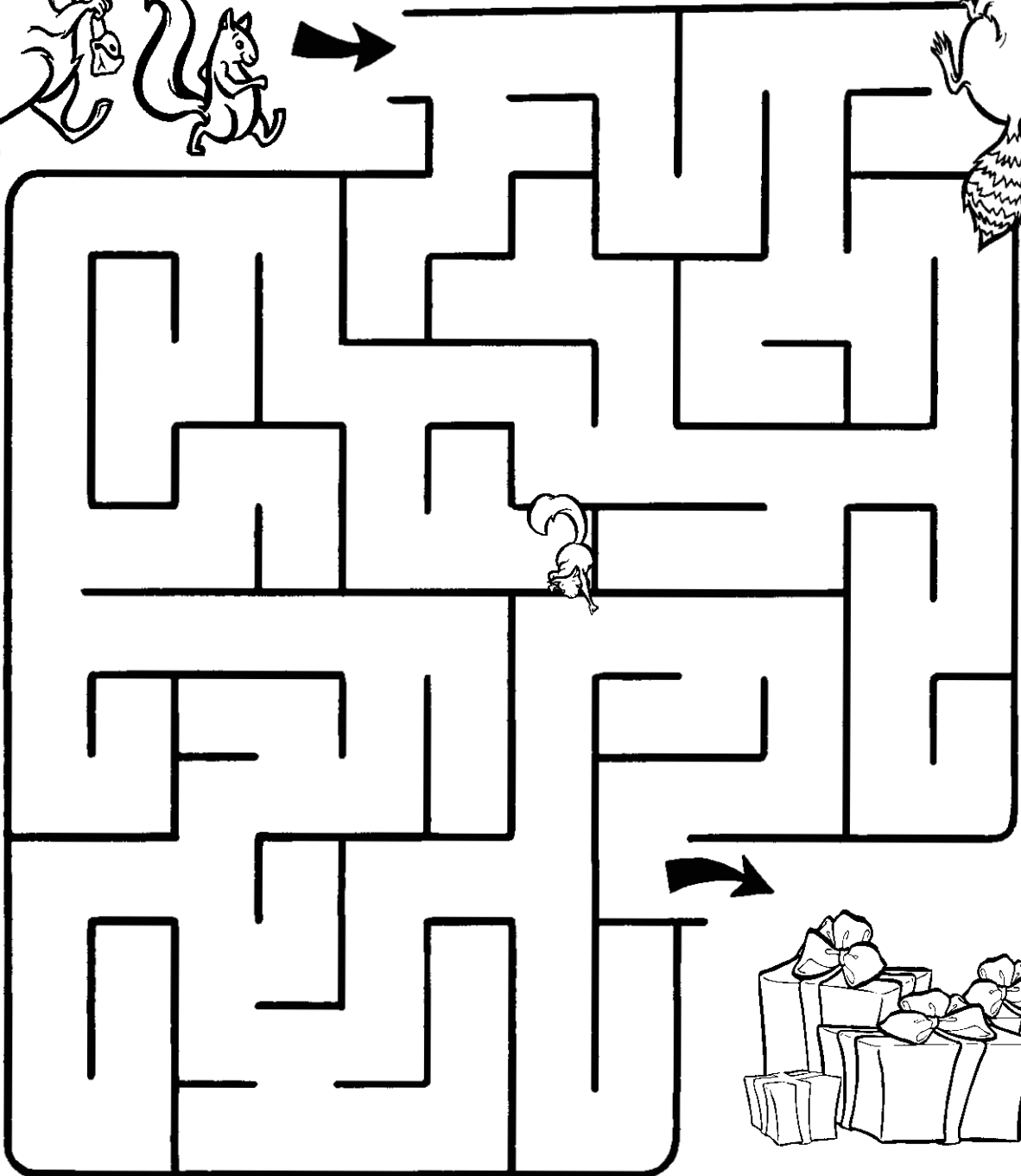


If you hang stockings over the fireplace,
