

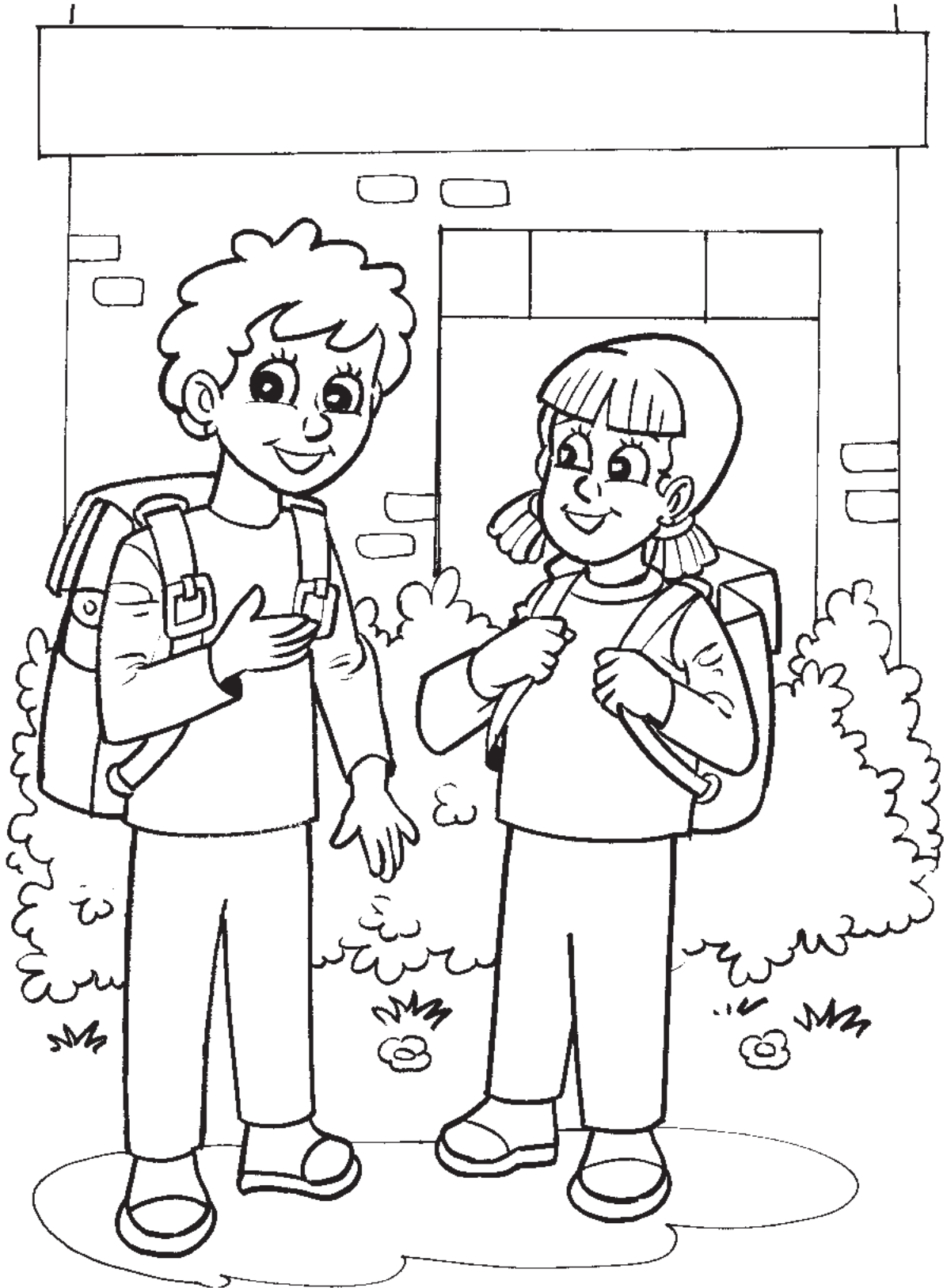
SANTA VISITED ME!



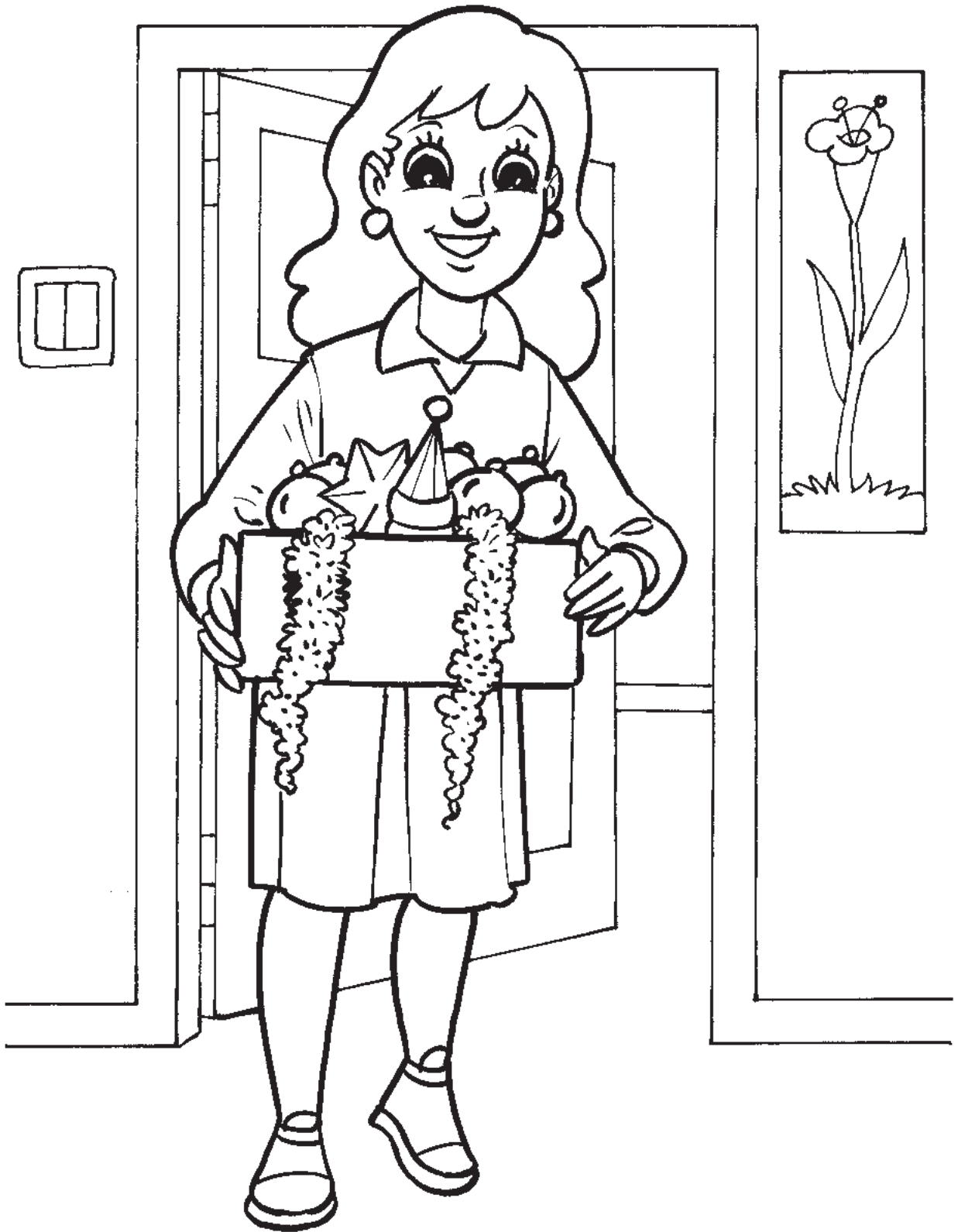

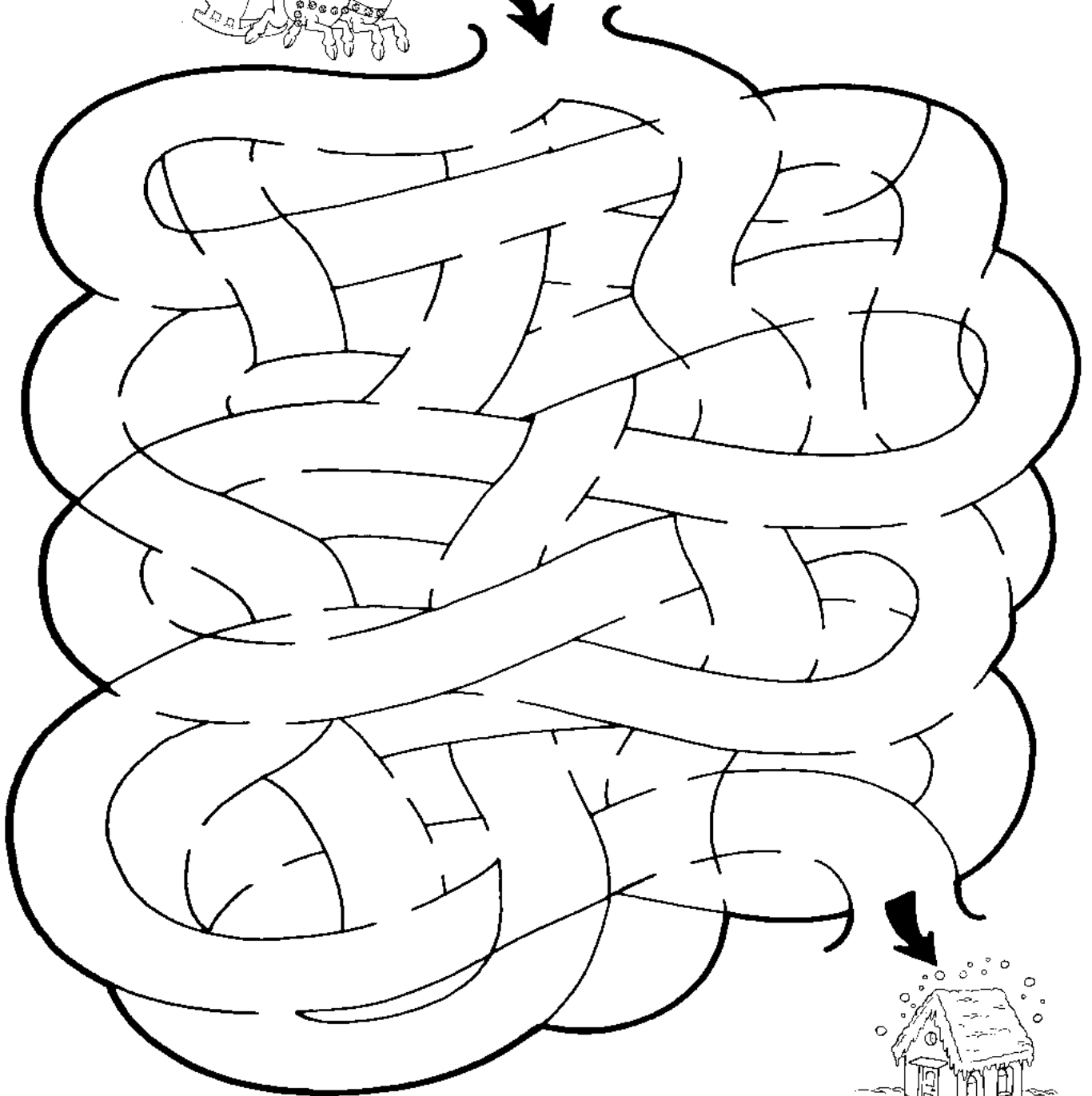

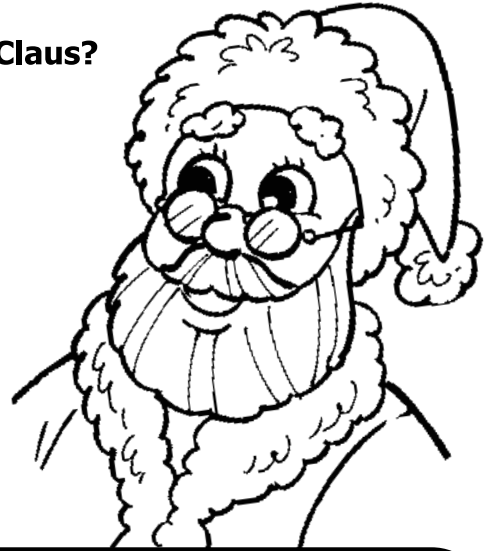
