



Plan an escape route with your family. Know how to exit each room. Arrange for a meeting place outside. Make sure it is away from the house.








Smoke detectors help save lives. Make sure there is one on every floor of your house.












- 1. Place a lid on a grease fire.

If your clothing catches fire, never panic and run. Remember to Stop, Drop, and Roll. Practice rolling on the ground.






Fire drills are very important. Follow instructions to the exit. Be orderly and quiet. Find the words in the puzzle below and circle them.

















Do not open a door that feels hot. Crawl on your hands and knees if there is heavy smoke. Go to the nearest exit.
