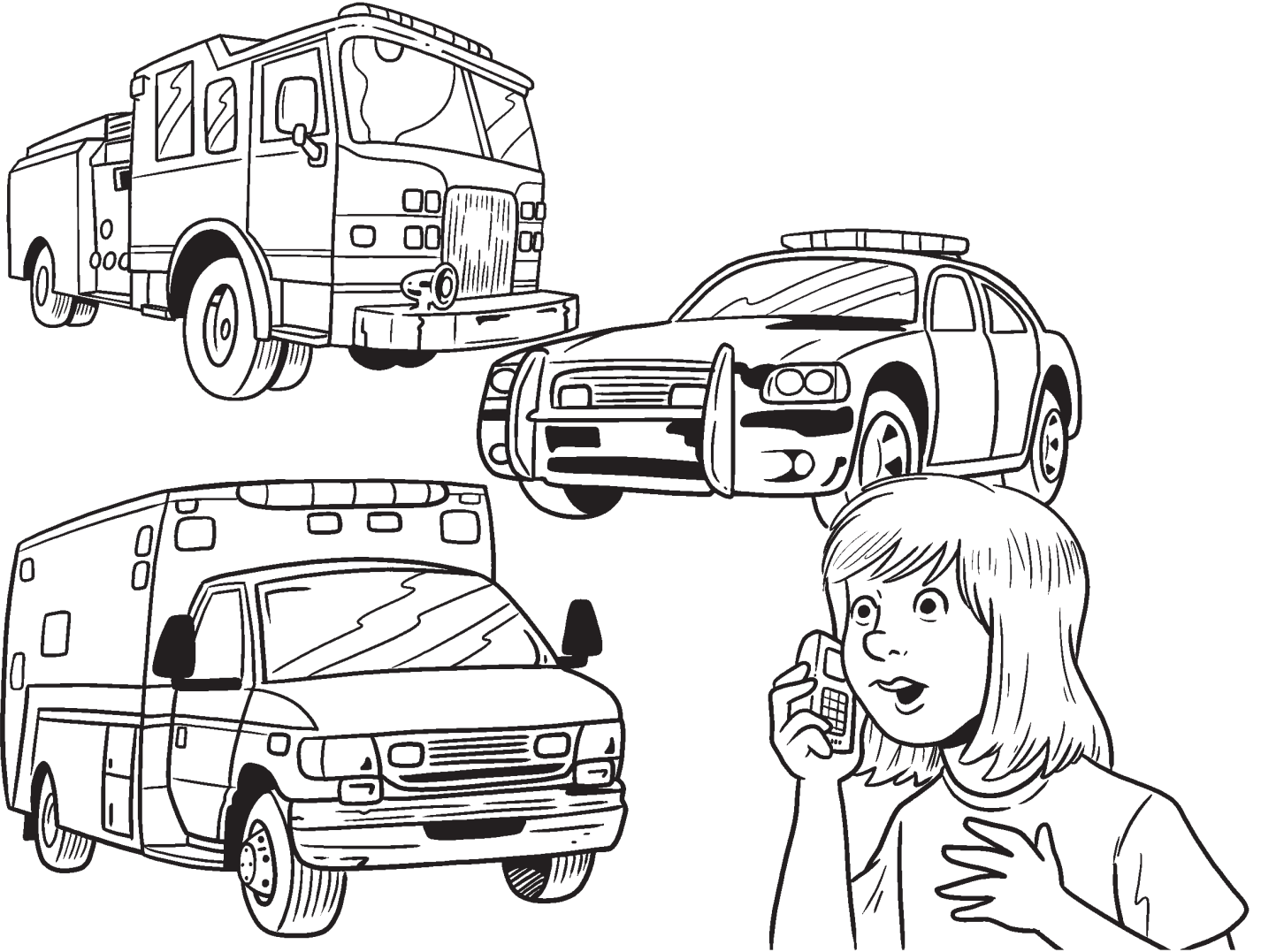

There is a number you can quickly call for help in an emergency. That number is 9-1-1.



Know how to call for help!

When you call 9-1-1 for an emergency it is important to try and remain calm and provide as much information as possible. Listen carefully to what the dispatcher is telling you to do. Stay on the phone until help arrives.

Keep all important emergency numbers near your phone.

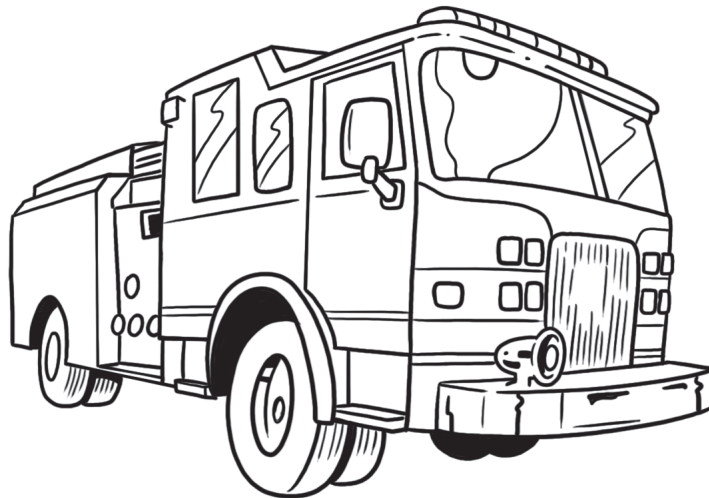

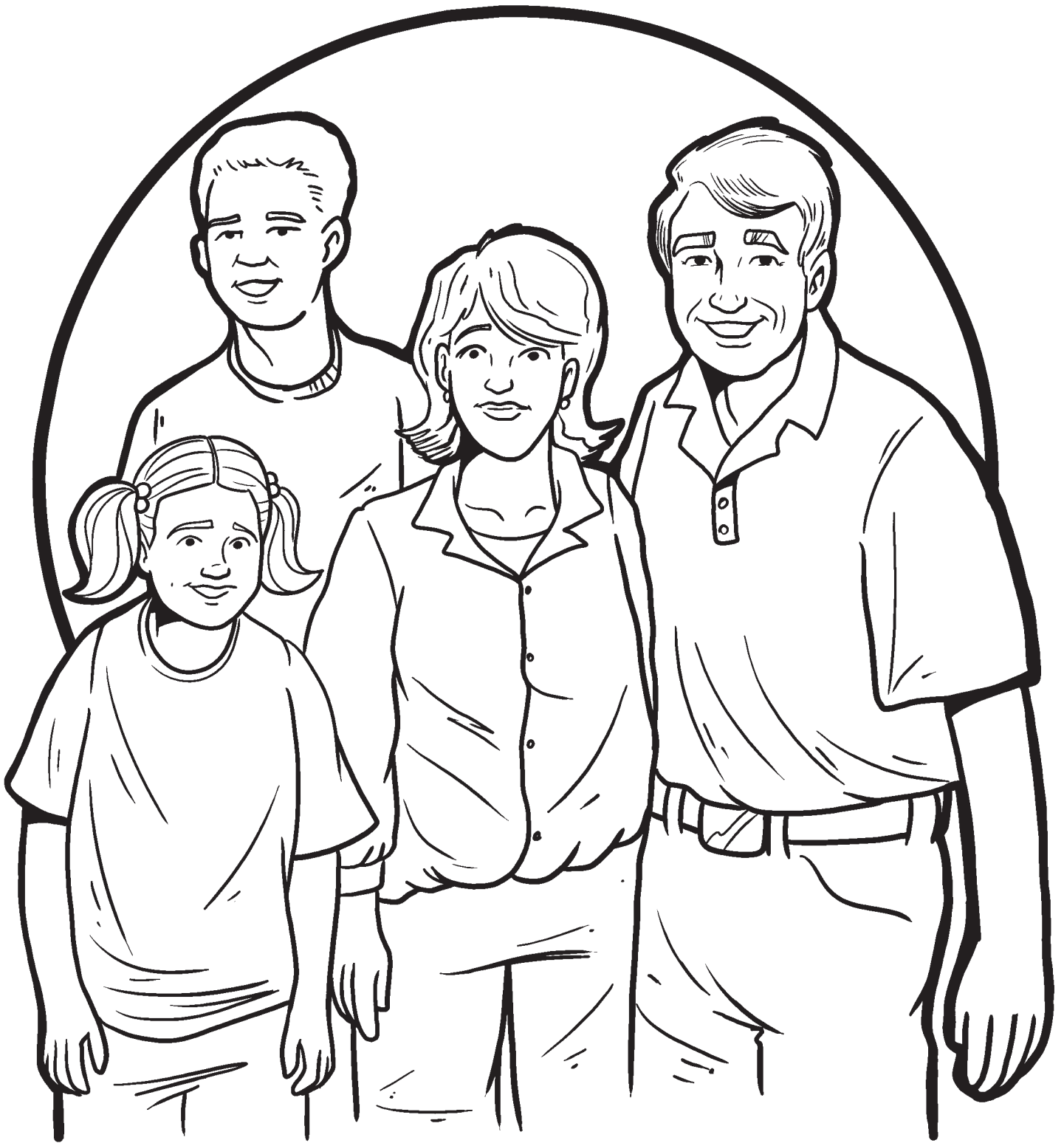
