




Halloween is fun, but it is even more fun when you stay safe.



Make sure your costume fits and is not too long or heavy. If you wear a mask, make sure the eye holes are large enough for you to see clearly or try face paint instead.




Connect the dots.

Always ask an adult to carve a pumpkin for you.




Draw a face on the pumpkin.

Stop only at houses that are well lit. Never go into a house, building or car.




Stay away from animals or pets you don't know.
