Don't take any chances that your parents forbid.



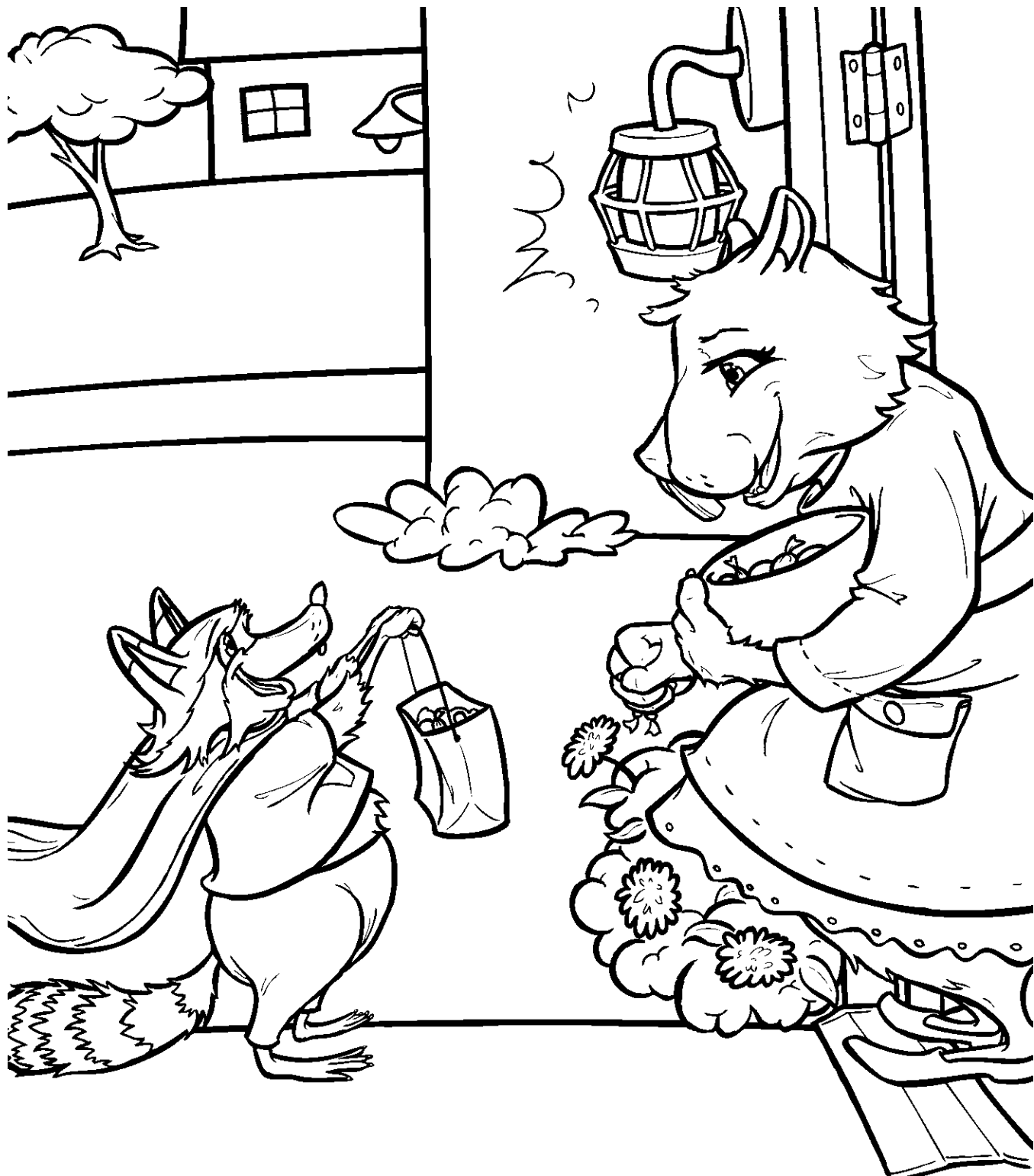
# FUN DRAW!

should have one to call help if you need to.

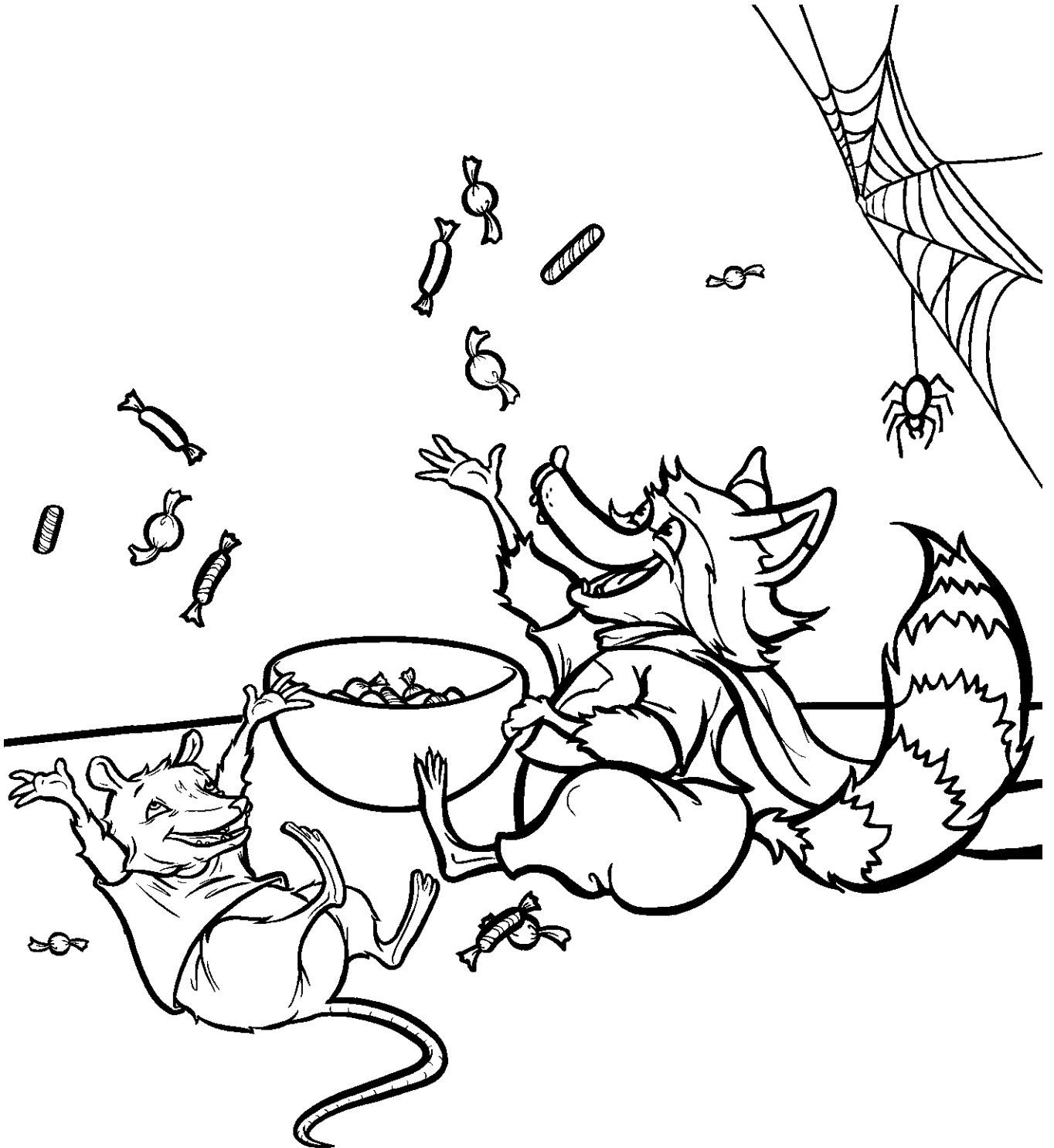
A cell phone is good to call 911,
