Almost everything EMTs need to do their job is inside the ambulance.



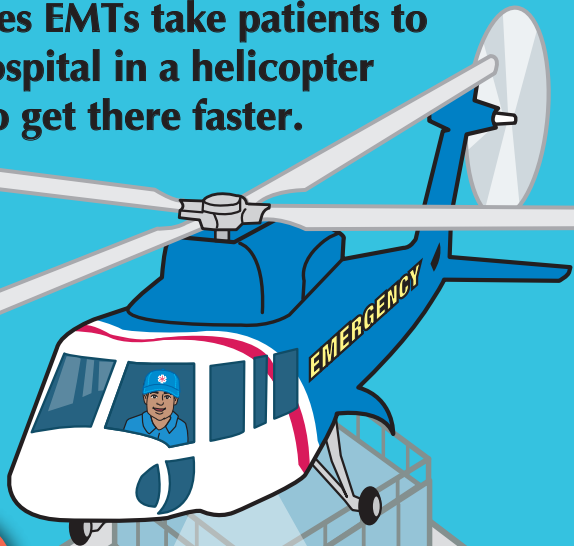
The EMTs drive the person to the hospital with flashing lights and sirens to tell other drivers,
